

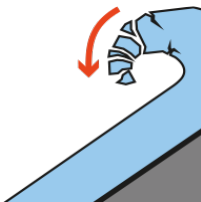

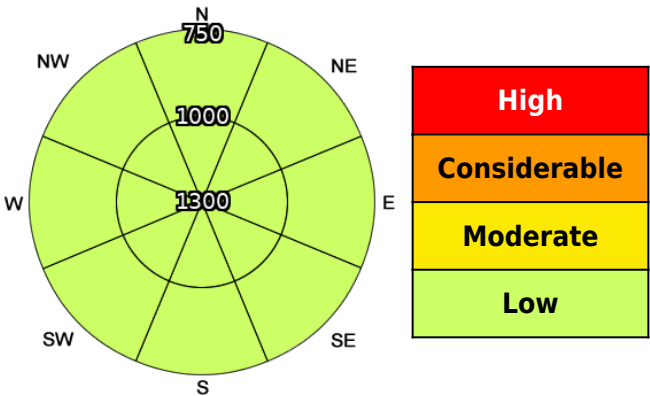

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw, soften, and diminish in extent. Greatest amounts on North to East aspects above 950 metres. Stability will be generally good throughout with some surface instabilities possible on steep snow slopes. Rockfall will be a hazard below crags. Any remaining cornices in high locations above East aspects will be liable to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Rain is expected overnight at all levels, it is expected to be dry during the day. Freezing levels will be above the summits throughout the forecast period. Winds moderate to strong Southerly.
