

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 30/03/2017


Avalanche Problems



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain soft and moist at levels, general stability will remain good on all but the steepest slopes where surface instabilities is possible. Remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. Hazard of rockfall will remain below crags. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will remain above the summits, rain at all levels, heavy at times overnight becoming drizzle through the day. Winds will be variable Southerly mainly fresh but with some stronger gusts.

Comments

Snowpack retreating gracefully with the mild moist conditions, greatest accumulations remain in the high North and East corries.
