



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The limited snowpack on North to East aspects above 950 metres will continue to deplete but will generally be consolidated and stable throughout. Some surface instabilities are possible on the steepest slopes. Rockfall will be a continuing hazard below crags. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Freezing levels around 2000 metres throughout. Some rain showers overnight, becoming persistent during the day. Winds moderate South-east to South-Westerly.
