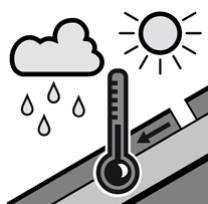
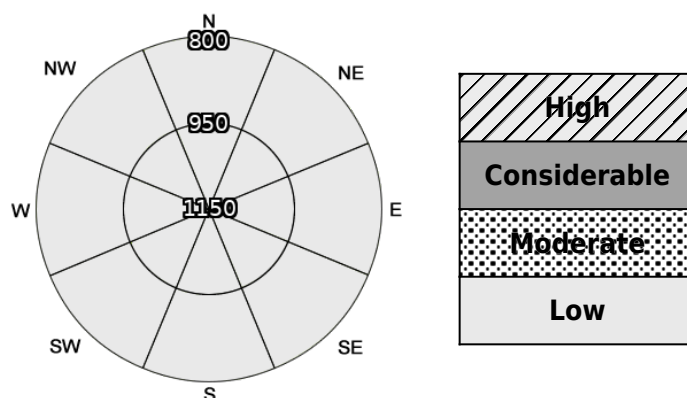

There will be little change to the current situation with the broken snow cover continuing to thaw and soften. Wet snow surface instabilities may be found on steeper slopes but otherwise overall stability will remain good. Rock fall will remain a hazard. Greatest amounts of snow will be found on North to East aspects above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low

**Forecast Weather Influences**

A mild day with heavy rain at all levels. Winds veering from the South-South-East to the West-South-West throughout the day becoming strong by the end of the afternoon.
