
Avalanche Problems



Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The depleting snowpack on North to Easterly aspects above 950 metres will continue to diminish and remain well bonded and stable throughout. Some surface instabilities are possible on very steep slopes. Rockfall will be a potential hazard during the thaw conditions. Any new snow accumulations at summit levels are expected to be insignificant. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

A dry night with strong South-West winds easing to light, the freezing level will remain above the summits. During the day light to moderate winds will veer North-Westerly with rain though the afternoon. This will turn to sleet and snow over the highest summits.
