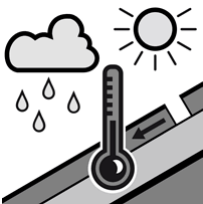


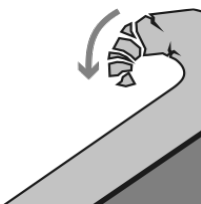

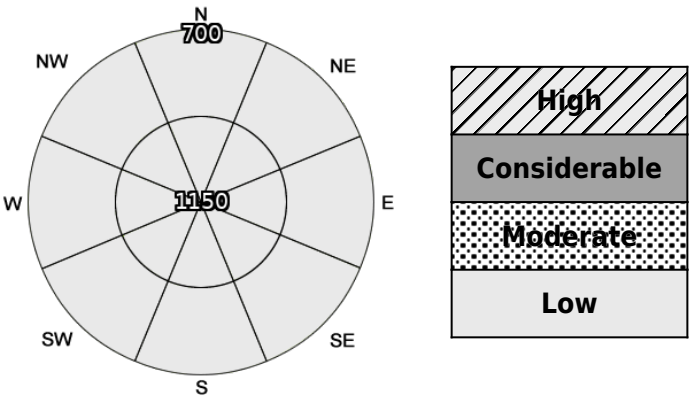
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will become soft and moist through the day as rain affects the area, general snowpack stability will remain good on all but the steepest slopes where surface wet snow instabilities may develop. Any remaining cornices prone to collapse. Loose rock will remain a hazard. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light rain and drizzle at all levels on Saturday. The freezing level will be around 1200 metres for much of the period. Winds will be moderate to fresh from a variable Westerly direction.
