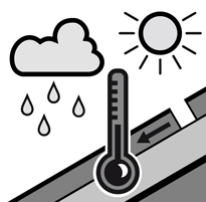


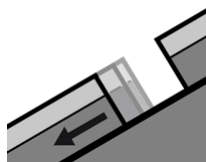

Avalanche Problems



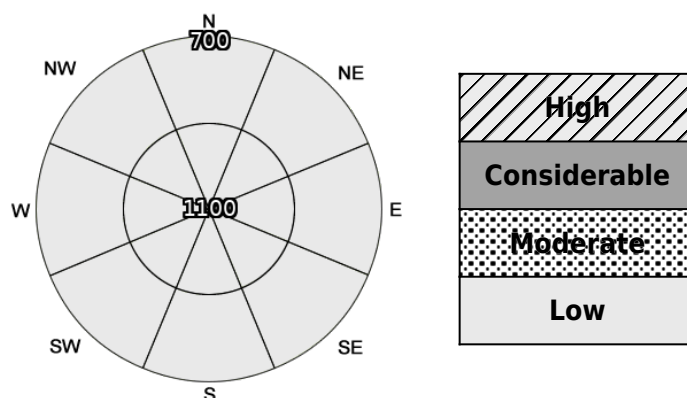
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The remaining patchy snowpack will remain well bonded and stable in most locations. Some wet and suspect cornices still exist above mainly North-East and East facing coire backwalls. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry overnight with the temperatures just above summits. It will mostly dry during the day with only a few showers affecting the area again by early afternoon. The winds will be light South-Westerly veering North-West as the day progresses.
