



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 02/04/2017

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The depleting patchy snow pack which is mainly on North through East to South-East aspects above 850 meters will continue to consolidate. Ridges and much of the terrain is bare of snow. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Fresh winds will be variable South-Westerly by tomorrow. Some very light showers are expected at first giving a hint of light snow on the summits as the freezing level lowers to around 850 metres overnight, rising to 1000 meters by tomorrow.

A drizzly day, nice in the glen although poor visibility on the summits.
