
#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The stable snowpack on North to Easterly aspects above 950 metres will become firmer overnight before softening again through the day. Surface instabilities are possible on some steep sun exposed slopes. Rockfall will be a continuing hazard. Any new accumulations of snow will be insignificant. The avalanche hazard will be Low



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Slightly cooler temperatures with light showers during the early part of the night falling as sleet and snow above 1000 metres. Dry for the rest of the period with sunny spells during the day. Moderate North-West winds backing South-Westerly. The freezing level will fall to 1000 metres overnight before rising to well above the summits through the day.
