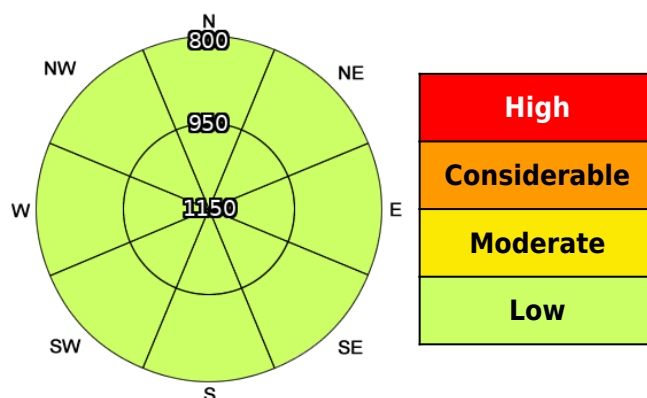

The broken snow cover will continue to thaw in the mild and wet conditions. There may be some surface layer instability on the very steepest of ground, otherwise the snow will be soft but stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

A very windy day with the freezing level above the summits. Dry in the morning with rain in the afternoon.
