

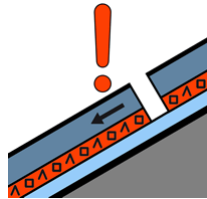
## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE

#### Avalanche Problems



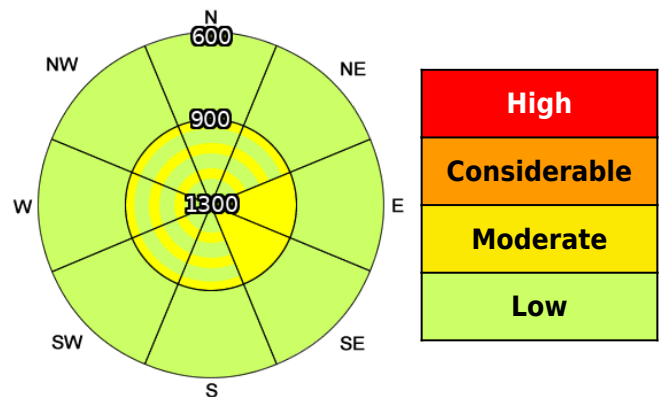
Wind Slab

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Drifting at higher levels with moderately bonded windslab continuing to develop mainly on steep sheltered North-East through East to Southerly aspects above 900 metres. Some isolated instabilities possible on other steep areas; however stability will be mostly good. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Light snowfall above 400 metres is expected to clear overnight to leave a dry day. Moderate to strong North-West winds will gradually ease and back to the West by the end of the day. The freezing level will be around 500 metres.

#### Comments

Very poor visibility, snow shoes a preferable mode of travel today.
