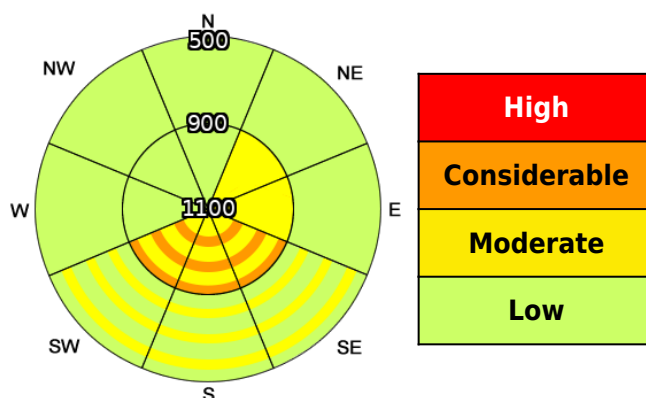

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Instability will persist in localised deeper accumulations of wind drifted snow on very steep East through South to South-West aspects above 900 metres. Better stability on recently scoured West to North aspects above 800 metres. Snow at most lower altitudes will show early consolidation. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Any light snow showers will die out overnight leaving a cold, bright day. Moderate North-Westerly winds will ease and become light West-South-Westerly by the end of the afternoon.

Comments

A few older cornices above N and E aspects. Saturday looking like the pick of weekend weatherwise. Quite good snow cover in lower Coire Ardair on Friday.
