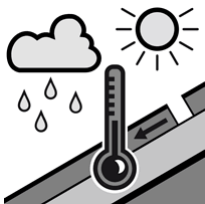


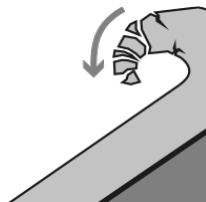

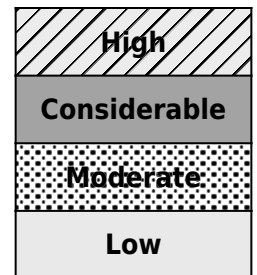
Wet Snow

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Overnight, the moist snowpack will start to consolidate in the cooler temperatures but as the freezing level rises to 2500 metres the snowpack will thaw leading to surface wet snow instabilities on all steep slopes. North to East aspects above 850 metres will be mostly affected and cornices unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

Mainly dry through the forecast period, the strong West-North-West winds will ease becoming South-South-Westerly. Overnight, the freezing level will be around the summits then during the day it will rise to well above summit level giving thaw conditions.

**Comments**

Quite mild for the next two days and strengthening Southerly winds.
