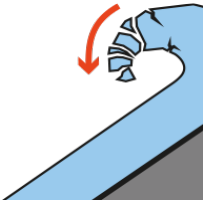

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 18/12/2017

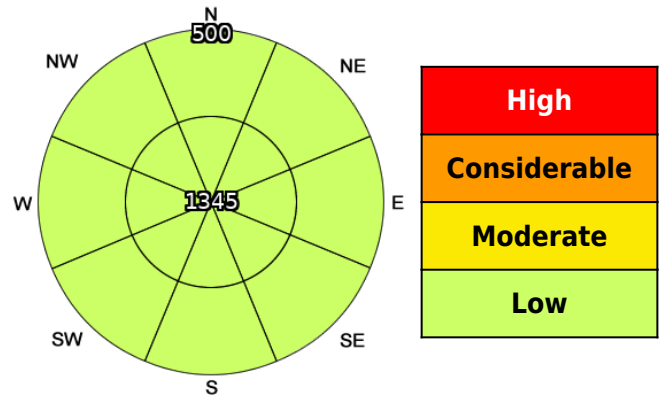
Avalanche Problems



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Overnight the snowpack above 900 metres will consolidate in the colder conditions. Below this level it will continue to slowly thaw and consolidate. Through the day the snowpack will gently thaw and consolidate at all levels. Stability will be generally good. However, a few unstable sections of cornice will remain. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain generally dry throughout the forecast period. Overnight the freezing level will be around 900 metres rising above the summits during the morning.

Comments

Generally mild conditions expected over the next few days.
