

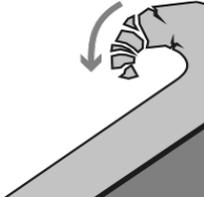



Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The melt freeze cycle will improve snowpack stability during the cooler temperatures. As the freezing level rises the surface will soften and begin to thaw. A few minor surface instabilities are possible in areas of steep terrain; however the snowpack will be generally stable. Any remaining cornices will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

A brief spell of snow during the early evening before becoming dry throughout. Winds will be strong Westerly. The 700 metre freezing level will quickly rise to well above the summits during the early morning and remain so through the day.

Comments

A major thaw expected before turning cooler over the highest tops midweek.
