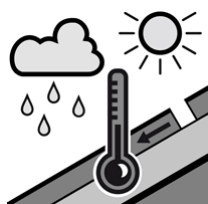


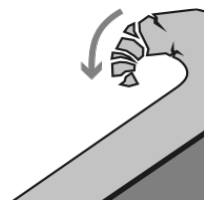

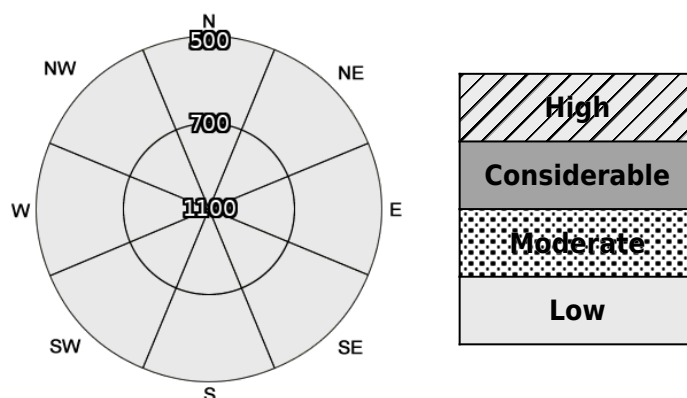
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw and become wet but remain reasonably well stabilised in most locations. Some minor wet snow surface instability in a few very steep locations mainly on East to South aspects above 850m. Remaining cornices in these locations will continue to soften and become collapse-prone. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Some overnight rainfall at all levels then dry. Remaining mild at all levels throughout. Light to moderate West South Westerly winds during the day.

Thaw now well established right to summits.
