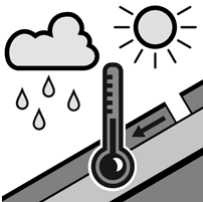


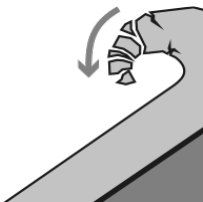

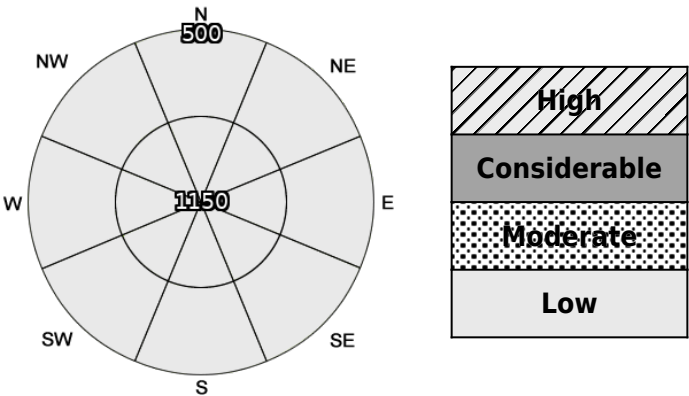
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The moist snowpack will continue to thaw and consolidate. Stability will be generally good at all levels. However, any remaining sections of cornice will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

A mild Westerly airstream will affect the area and it should be dry through the period. The strong West-South-Westerly winds will back to the South during the day and ease. The freezing level remains above the summits.

Comments

Outlook; mainly dry on Thursday night and into Friday with some light rain developing over western ranges later. Some heavier rain over the West Highlands from Friday evening.
