




# Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The moist snowpack will continue to thaw and consolidate. Stability will be generally good at all levels. However, any remaining sections of cornice will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.





## **Forecast Weather Influences**

It will remain dry throughout the forecast period with strong South-Westerly winds. The freezing level will be well above the summits.

#### **Comments**

Outlook; Mainly dry on Thursday night and into Friday, light rain will develop over western ranges later. Some heavier rain over the West Highlands from Friday evening especially in the Northwest with severe gale West to South-West winds the freezing levels well above the summits.
