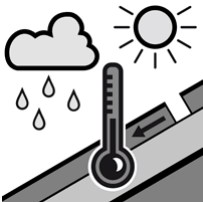


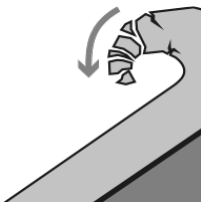

Avalanche Problems



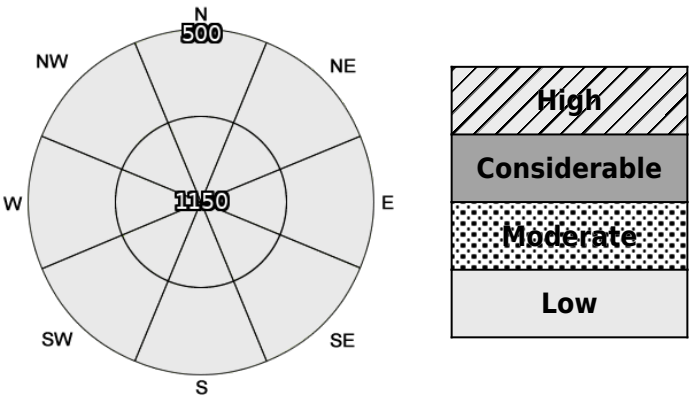
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected the moist snowpack will continue to thaw and consolidate. Stability will be generally good at all levels. However, any remaining sections of cornice will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

A very strong, mild South-Westerly airstream covers Scotland overnight and through Saturday. Outbreaks of rain and drizzle will become more persistent and occasionally heavy through Saturday afternoon. Winds will be West-South-West strong to gale force at times. The freezing level remains well above the summits.
