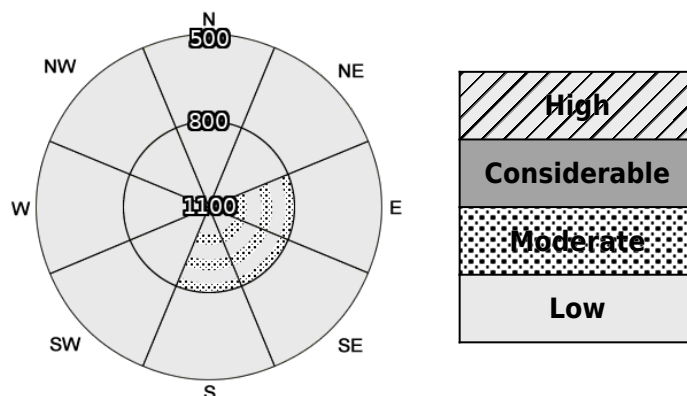
Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Should any new accumulations achieve depth, especially in the steepest gully tops and around sheltered coire rims above 800m, then localised areas of poorly bonded windslab will develop, these mainly on East and South-East facing aspects. The old deposits will be re-frozen and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Remaining cool with the freezing level staying below summits. Some further snow showers overnight, will become more isolated during the day. The light generally North Easterly overnight winds will freshen North Westerly as the day progresses.
