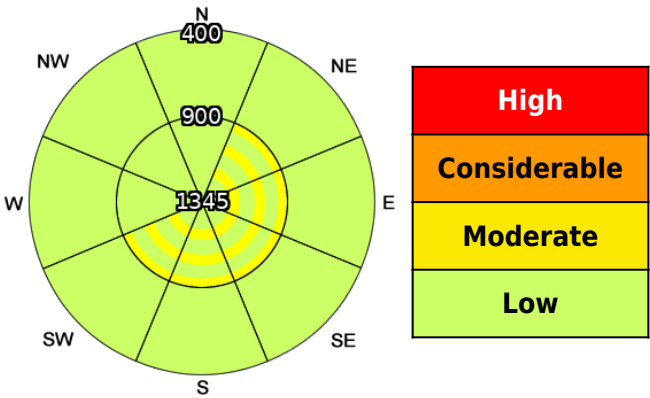
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of new unstable windslab will be deposited in sheltered locations, mainly on North-East through South-East to South-West aspects above 900 metres. Deeper accumulations are not expected to be extensive. The old snowpack will be refrozen and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will be around 400 metres. Some snowfall is expected overnight, then isolated snow showers during the day. Overnight winds will be mainly light Northerly backing and freshening North-Westerly; moderate mainly Westerly during the day.
