

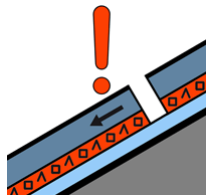

Avalanche Problems



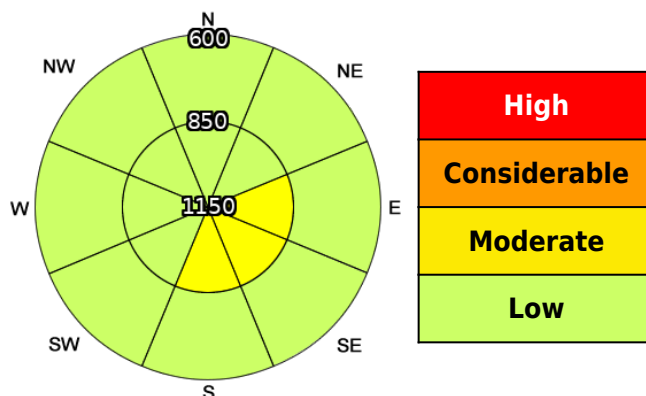
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of unstable windslab will form in wind sheltered locations on East to South aspects. Gully exits and corrie rims above 850 metres will be particularly affected. Elsewhere new snow will fall on bare ground and remain stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be moderate snowfall overnight from around 400 metres but it will be mainly dry during the day. Winds will increase to strong North-Westerly.
