

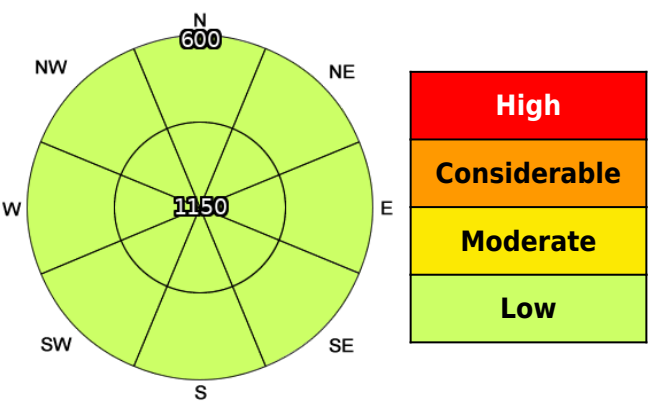

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 27/12/2017

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected. Patches of old, frozen and well consolidated snow will exist above about 700 metres. A dusting of fresh snow will remain above 600 metres. However, this will not be significant. Stability will be good. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain cold with a freezing level of around 300 metres. Winds will be from the North-West. It will be dry overnight, with a few isolated snow showers during the day.
