

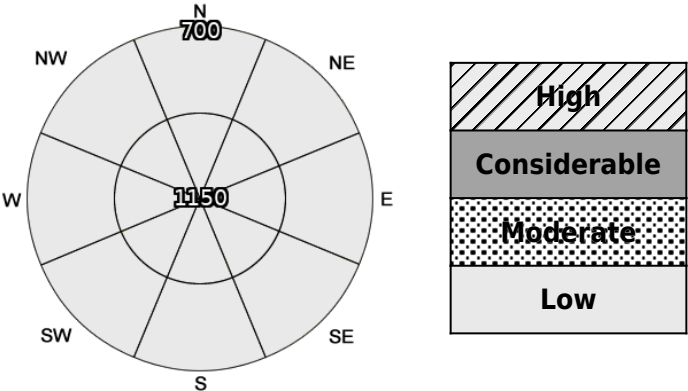

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 28/12/2017

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected in the snowpack. Patchy areas of old snow will be found above 700 metres. These areas will continue to freeze and consolidate and will be stable. There will be a thin and superficial dusting of soft newer snow. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain cold with a freezing level around 300 metres throughout the forecast period. After some light overnight snow showers it will be a generally dry day. Westerly winds will ease.
