

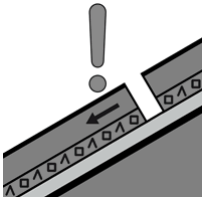

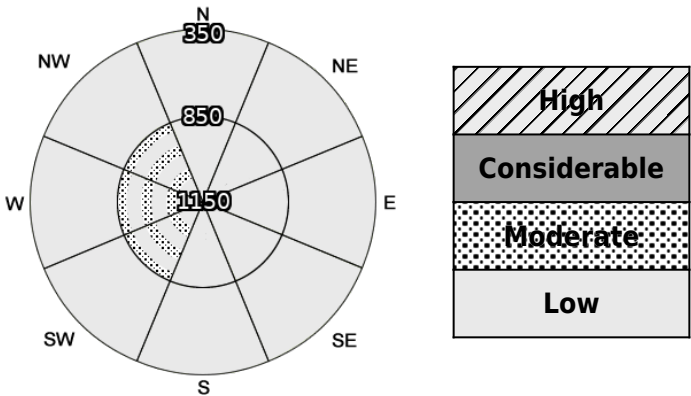
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The confidence in new snow amounts is not certain and it could well stay dry. However, if snow showers fall on strong Easterly winds then localised shallow deposits of moderately bonded windslab will develop in sheltered locations. Areas mostly affected will be on steep South-West to North-West aspects about 850 metres. Elsewhere the snowpack will generally be stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, dry and cold conditions with a frost at all levels. During the day snow showers forecast to all levels at first then above 200 metres. South-Westerly winds will back to East by early morning and strengthen.
