

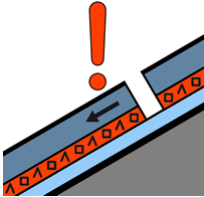

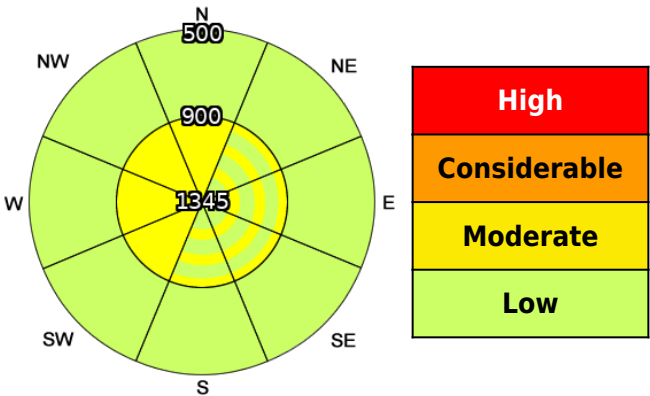
Wind Slab



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of unstable windslab will be present on most aspects above 900 metres. Redistribution of existing snow will deposit fresh unstable windslab on South-West through West to North aspects. Existing localised windslab will be present on North-East through East to South aspects. The old snowpack will be frozen hard and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be mainly dry throughout the period with the freezing level around 400 metres. Overnight winds will be South-Easterly; strengthening during the morning to strong East-South-Easterly before easing moderate Easterly during the afternoon.
