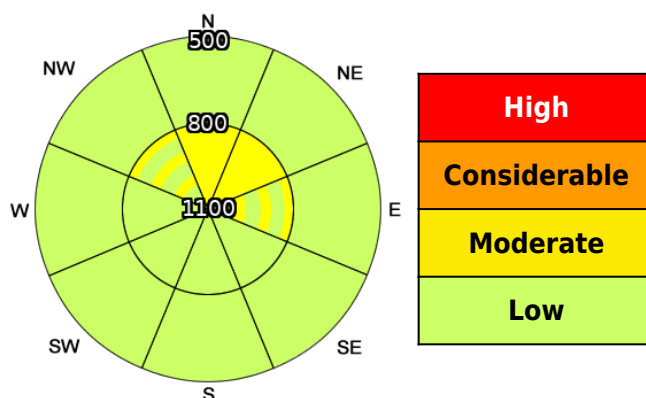
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Poorly bonded windslab will begin develop and achieve depth in high, sheltered, mainly North to North Easterly aspects above 800m. The old patches of existing snow will be re-frozen and hard. Good stability on exposed hillsides which will remain wind scoured and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain cold and dry overnight. Further snow showers will affect the area during the day, particularly mid-afternoon, as the light overnight South Easterly winds strengthen South West, then West South West bringing wintry conditions above 500m.

Comments
