

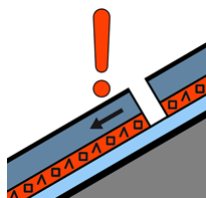

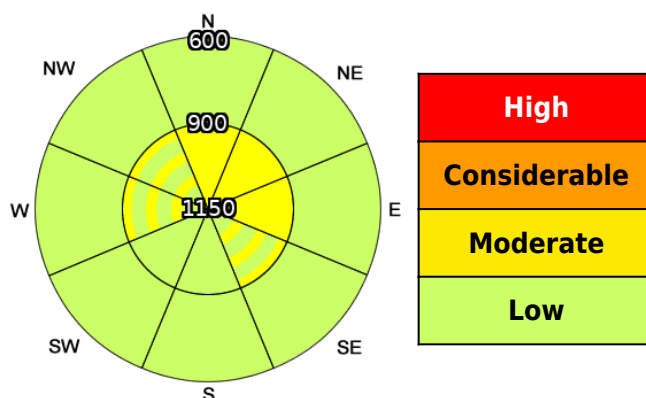
Wind Slab



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be localised areas of unstable windslab present in very sheltered locations on most aspects above 900 metres. Greatest hazard will be found on North to East aspects where significant drifting in strengthening winds will lead to deep unstable accumulations developing. Corrie rims and gully exits will be particularly affected. Elsewhere, older snow will be firm and icy. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be snow showers throughout the day above 600 metres. Winds will strengthen from the South then the South-West.

Comments

General conditions are still lean with changeable winds starting to fill hollows and burs. Very icy underfoot.
