

Wind Slab





Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Existing unstable windslab will remain, mainly on South-West through West to North aspects above 900 metres, though also on other aspects. Additionally, through the day, fresh unstable windslab will be deposited in sheltered areas, mainly on North to East aspects. Cornices will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight it is expected to be mainly dry with light to moderate South-South-East winds. During the day there will be snowfall initially above 500 metres, later above 700 metres as the freezing level rises to around 800 metres. Winds during the day will start moderate South-Easterly then veer and strengthen to strong South-Westerly.
