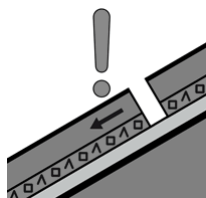
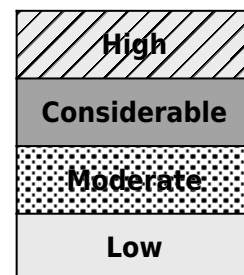
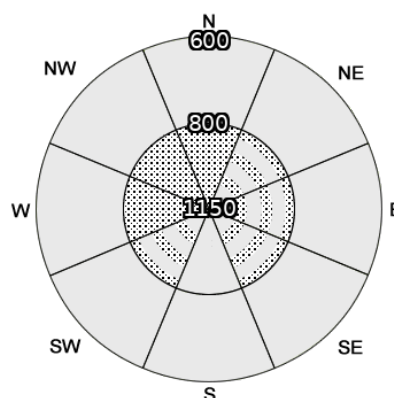


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 31/12/2017****Avalanche Problems****Wind Slab****Persistent Weak Layers****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Strong, variable winds will deposit and then redistribute new accumulations onto many aspects from South-West through North to South-East above 800 metres. Newly deposited snow will be moderately bonded with steeper, sheltered features such as corrie rims and gully exits holding moderately to poorly bonded snow. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

There will be a period of snowfall during the early hours until mid-morning. Winds will be variable in direction but will increase to be strong for most of the period. Freezing level will be around 650 metres.

Comments

Careful route choice required due to variable winds creating stability issues on many aspects.
