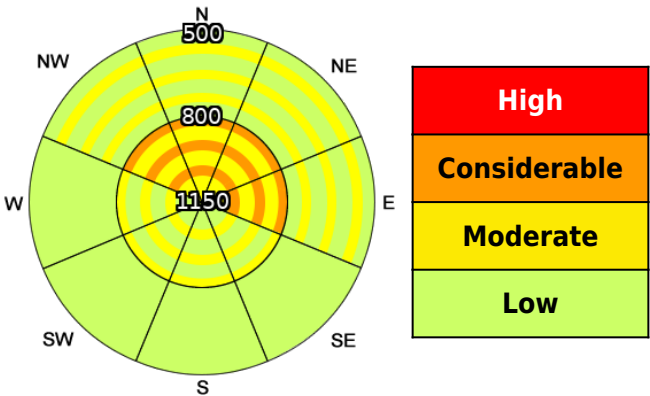
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of unstable windslab will develop above 800 metres overnight and through the day. These areas are not expected to be particularly extensive. The tops of North-West through North to East facing slopes and gullies will be most affected. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be a showery day, with these falling as snow above 500 metres. The freezing level will be around 650 metres. Winds, which will be variable in direction, will generally ease through the period.
