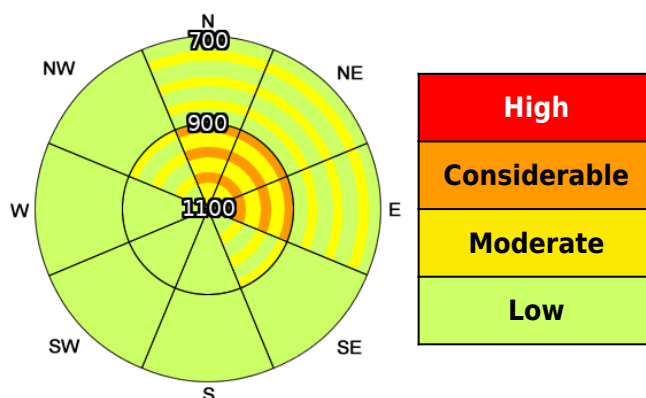

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New weak windslab expected on steeper North to East aspects above 900 metres with instability expected to be localised and confined to deeper snow at gully exits and coire rims. Newly formed cornices in these locations will be weak. Consolidation of recent and older snow expected on less steep ground and at lower altitudes from late morning onwards. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Light persistent snowfall overnight and during the morning. Westerly later Southerly winds, moderate to strong easing to light by dawn. Freezing around 700m throughout.
