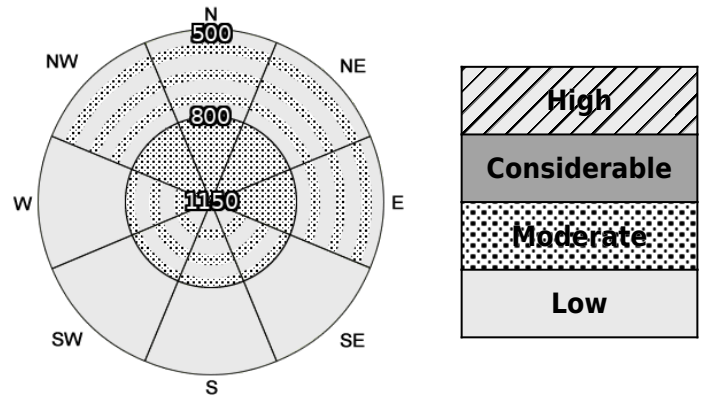
**Avalanche Problems**

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Areas of unstable windslab will be deposited. Most affected will be the tops of North-West to North-East aspects above 800 metres. Some older instabilities will remain on Easterly aspects above 800 metres. None of these deposits are expected to be particularly extensive. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

After a dry night a band of precipitation will cross the area during the morning and early afternoon. This will fall as snow initially above 500 metres, rising to 800 metres. The freezing level will rise from 600 metre to around 900 metres. Strong winds will be from the South.
