

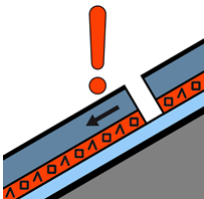

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 02/01/2018

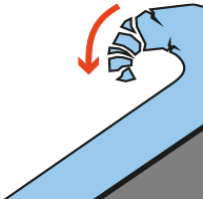

Wind Slab



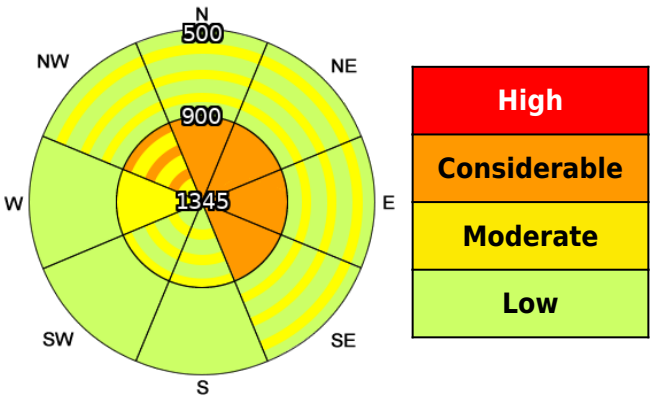
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Existing unstable windslab will remain, mainly on North through East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. During the day additional fresh unstable windslab will be deposited in sheltered areas, mainly on North-West to North-East aspects above 900 metres. Other aspects may also be affected due to cross loading. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be mainly dry overnight with moderate Westerly backing Southerly winds. During the day snowfall is expected above 600, later 800, metres, with moderate to strong generally Southerly winds. The freezing level will be around 800 metres.
