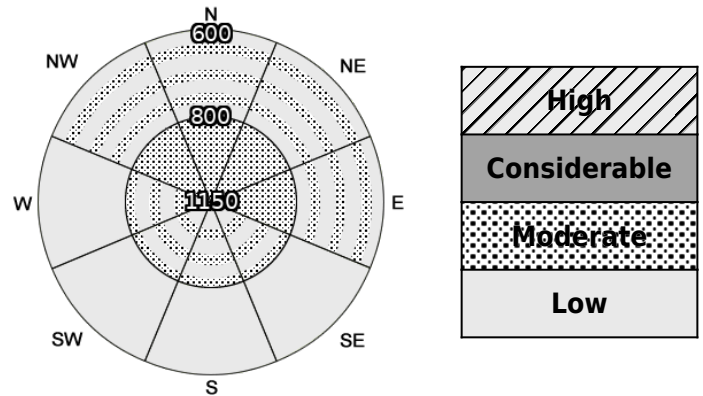
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of moderately bonded windslab will exist and build in sheltered locations above 800 metres. Although these are possible on many aspects, North to East aspects will be most affected. However, these areas are not expected to be particularly extensive. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers will continue through the period. The wind will be variable in direction at first, and then from the South West. The freezing level will be around 600 metres overnight, rising to 900 metres during the day.

Comments

Snow cover continuing to slowly improve at higher levels in the Glen Coe.
