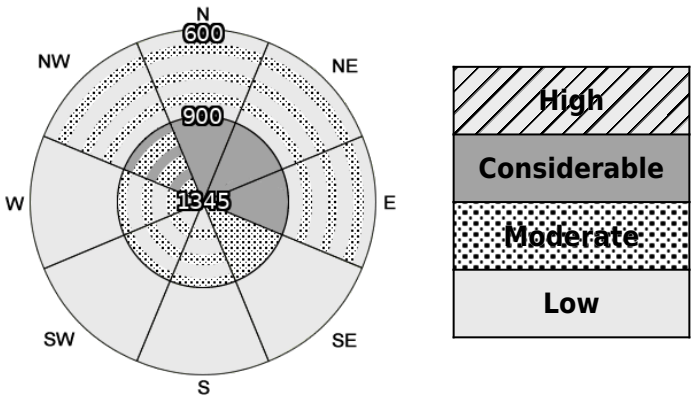

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh unstable windslab will be present and continue to be deposited in sheltered areas, mainly on North-West through North to East aspects above 900 metres. Older moderately bonded windslab will also persist. Recently formed cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds are expected to be moderate in strength throughout the period; variable in direction overnight, South-Westerly then generally Southerly during the day. Snow showers are expected throughout the forecast period. The freezing level will be around 800 metres.
