

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 05/01/2018


Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Snowpack stability will be generally good in most places. However, moderately well bonded windslab will persist in isolated very steep locations on North-West through North to South-East aspects above 950 metres, Gully exits, coire rims and steep convex terrain being most affected. Some instabilities at depth will also persist in these places, and especially where the snowpack becomes more shallow. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will be light Easterly overnight then veer North-Easterly for most of the day. Some light snow flurries are possible and the freezing level will be around 600 metres.
