

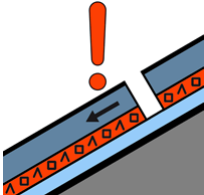

Avalanche Problems



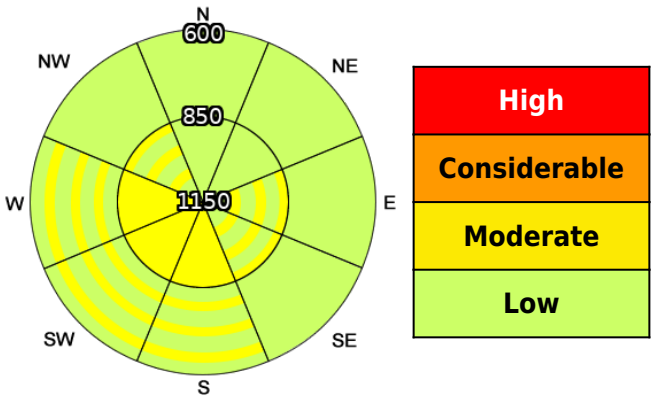
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will start to refreeze becoming firm in most locations during the day. New unstable windslab will continue to form mainly in sheltered locations above 850 metres on South to West aspects with other aspects also affected by cross-loading. Sheltered convex features, gully exits and scarp slopes will be especially affected. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Becoming colder with snowfall through until early afternoon. Initially above 600 metres but then to all levels, Winds, gale force at times, will mainly be from the North-North-East.

Comments

Likely to be significant drifting during the day.
