

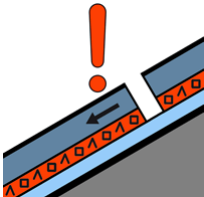

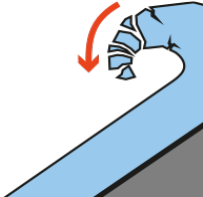
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



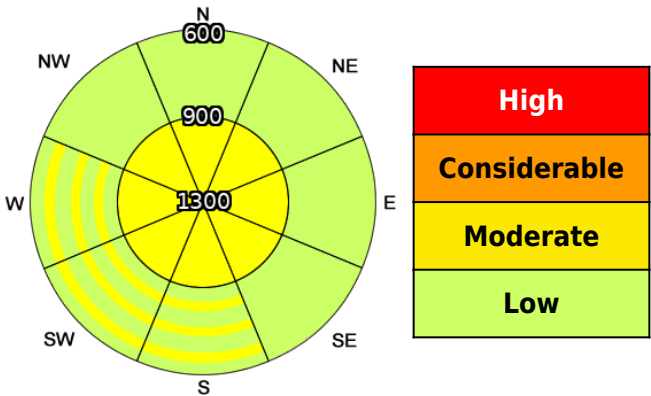
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Accumulations of unstable windslab will be present on many aspects above 900 metres. Most affected areas will be around steep convex terrain coire rims, crag aprons, flanks and gully tops. Some instabilities will remain at depth in these places especially where the snowpack becomes more shallow. Light drifting with new windslab expected to develop around coire rims and gully tops on North to East aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry overnight with sunshine during the day. Moderate to light North-East winds will veer to the South-South-West through the day. The freezing level will rise from 300 to 400 metres.
