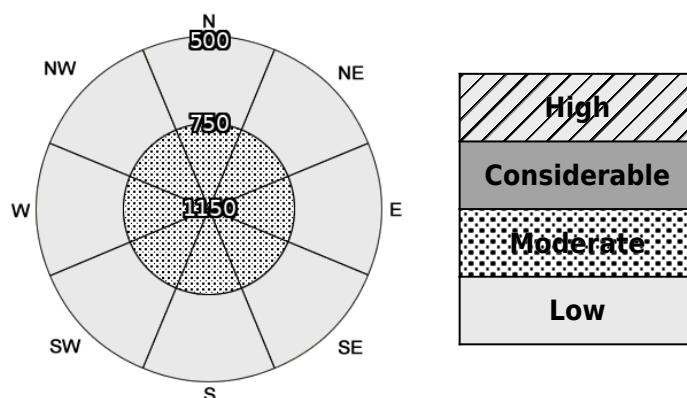
Wind Slab



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected in the snowpack. Areas of unstable windslab will be found in sheltered locations on many aspects above 750 metres. These areas will not tend to be particularly extensive. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain cold and dry with generally light winds. After a sharp overnight frost the freezing level won't rise far above sea level.
