

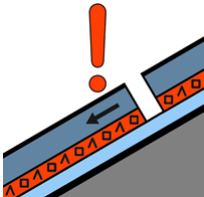

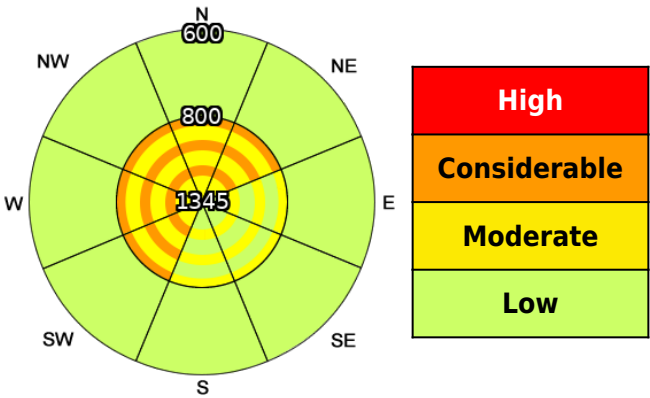
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh unstable windslab will form in locations sheltered from the strengthening South-East winds. Greatest accumulations will be at the tops of steep West, North-West and North aspects above 800 metres. Localised instabilities will remain in other locations. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be dry and cold with an increasing South-Easterly airflow.
