

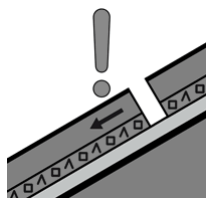

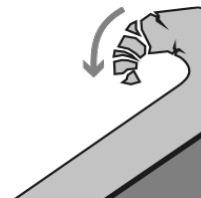

Wind Slab



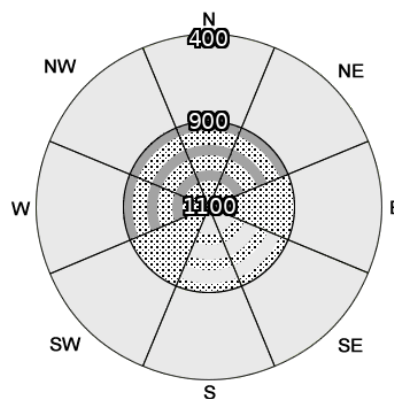
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New weakly bonded windslab will form mainly on West through to North aspects above 900m. Most affected areas will be gully tops and coire rims with cross-loading in some North-East facing gullies. Any newly formed cornices will be weak. Lingering instability will persist in older snow on steeper slopes of most aspects above 850m. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

No precipitation is forecast. Stronger South-East winds. Staying generally cold.
