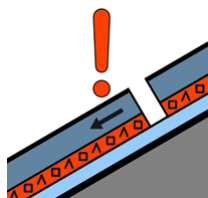
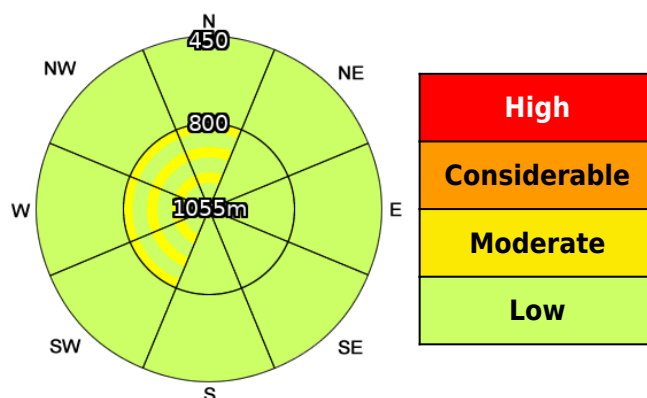


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 10/01/2018****Avalanche Problems****Persistent Weak Layers****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Some isolated pockets of windslab will persist in sheltered areas on South-West through to North facing aspects mainly above 800 meters. Otherwise the the general snowpack has good stability. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate

**Forecast Weather Influences**

The strong South South-Easterly wind will ease overnight and veer Southerly then West South-Westerly and become light. A temperature inversion will initially set the freezing level above the summits but this will drop overnight to around 600 meters. Some light showers overnight and during the day falling as snow above 600 meters.

Comments

Snow starting to consolidate which makes life easier if going off the beaten track. Ice falling from rock buttresses in the sun but building elsewhere.
