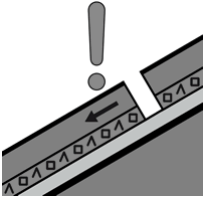

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 11/01/2018

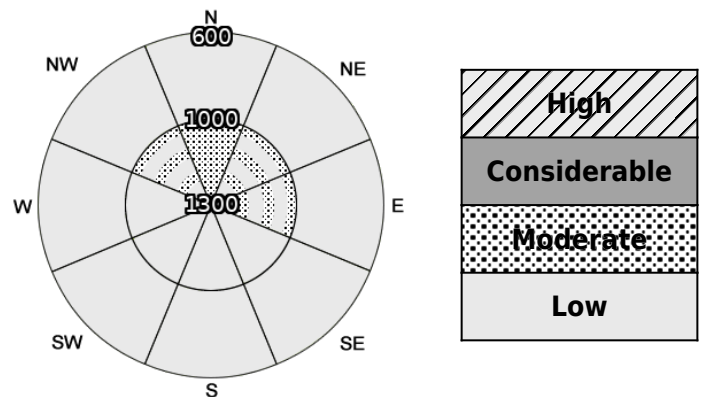
Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Stability will continue to improve in most areas. However within the localised snowpack areas on mostly North-West through North to North-Easterly aspects above 1000 metres, weaknesses persist at depth but are overlain with a very hard windslab layer. Most affected places will be steep convex terrain around corrie rims and gully exits. Below this level stability is good with many areas scoured and bare. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

A dry clear day is expected, with a freezing level around 800 metres. Light North-Westerly winds overnight veering through North becoming light South-Easterly at the end of the day.

Comments

Improved stability - weakness persist but are bridged by strong upper layers.
