

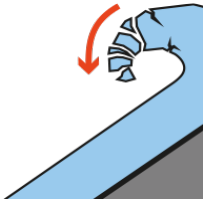

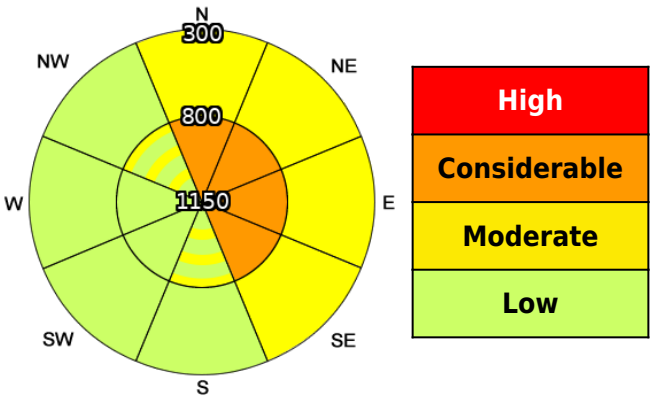
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of unstable windslab will continue to be deposited on sheltered North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres where avalanches are likely. Some weak cornices will exist above these aspects. Windward slopes will generally be scoured, hold little snow and be stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers will continue overnight and through the day. The wind will be from the West-South-West. The freezing level will be around 200 metres.
