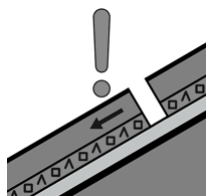
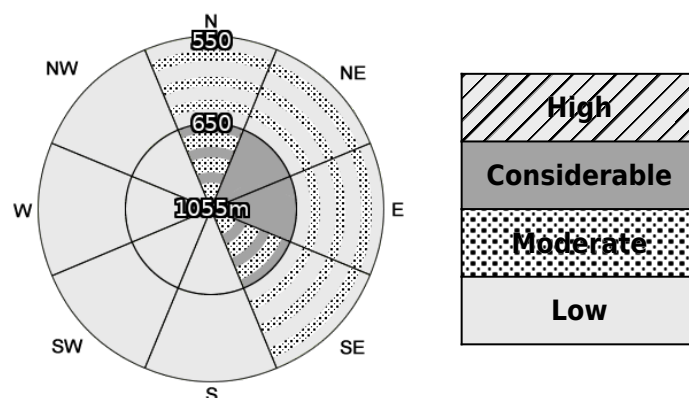

Wind Slab

Persistent Weak Layers
Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New and significant areas of windslab will add on to the existing poorly bonded and weak snowpack. Especially on North-East and East aspects above 650 meters. North and South-East aspects will also be affected. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.


Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will be generally fresh to strong West-South-West oscillating to South-West occasionally. Frequent heavy snow showers are forecast through the period. The freezing level will be remain low hovering around 300 meters.

Comments

Lots of trail breaking, weak layers within the snow pack above 650 metres.
