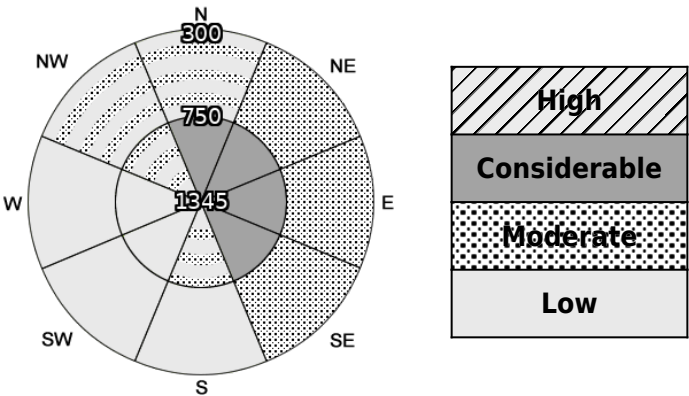

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Large areas of soft unstable windslab will continue to form in sheltered locations. Greatest accumulations will be on North, North-East and East aspects above 750 metres. Avalanches are likely in these locations. Existing instabilities will persist on South-East aspects. Localised instabilities will be present on other locations. Wind scoured slopes will be frozen and stable. Cornices will be unstable and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate to strong South-Westerly winds over the summits with frequent snow showers at all levels.
