

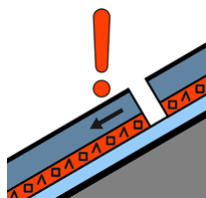

Wind Slab



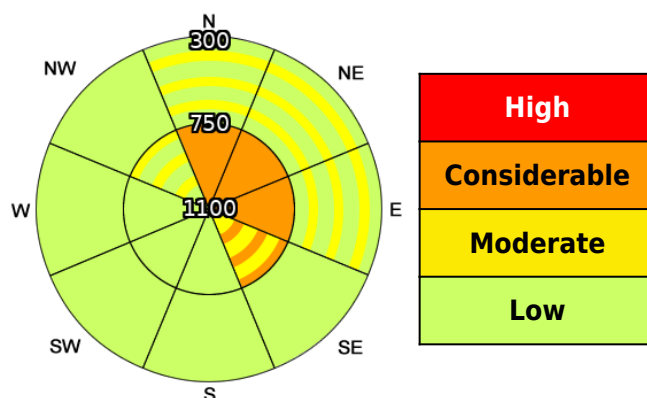
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Additional weakly stabilised windslab will build mainly on North through East to South-East aspects above 750 metres where avalanches are likely. Most affected areas will be steep gullies and coire rims. Large weak and collapse prone cornices already hang over steeper locations of the same aspects and further cornice development expected overnight. Better stability on all ridges and recent windward slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers will continue overnight but die out before dawn. Remaining cold with moderate West-South-West winds easing a little during the day.

Comments

Deep snow at glen level. Very deep drifts in all lee areas. Breaking trail on skis challenging from the roadside!
