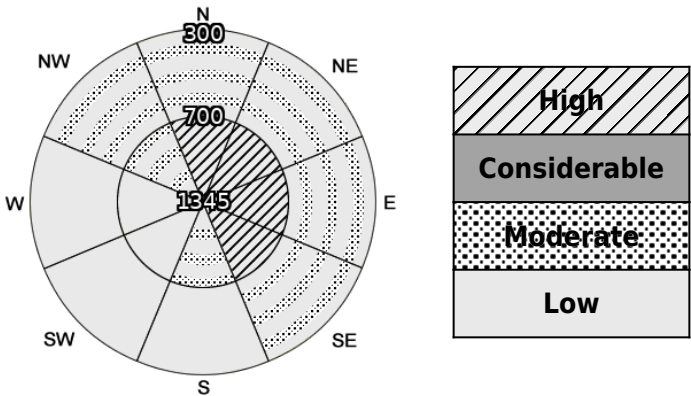

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will become increasingly unstable as the freezing level starts to rise during the day. Avalanches will occur, notably later in the day, mainly on steep North, North-East, East and South-East aspects above 700 metres. Localised instabilities will be present on other locations. Cornices will become increasingly unstable and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight it will be calm dry and cold. During Sunday morning, the winds will increase from the South-East, the freezing level will rise to summit level by evening and there will be a period of rain preceded by snow.
