

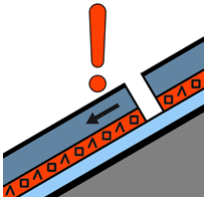

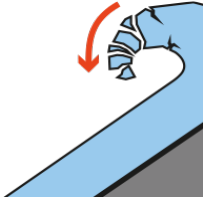

Wind Slab



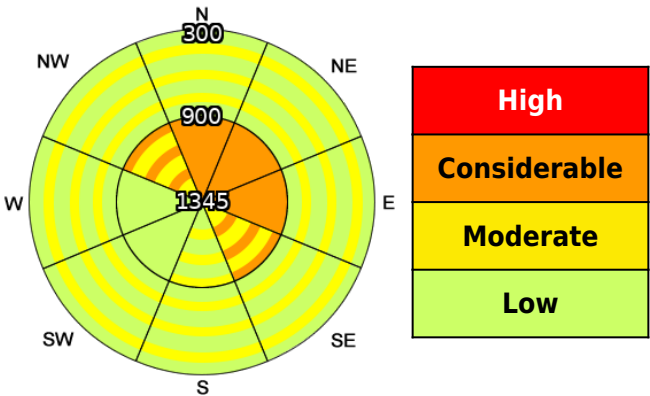
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh windslab will continue to develop over the existing unstable snow accumulations above 900 metres. Greatest accumulations will be on steep North, North-East and East aspects. Avalanches are likely in these locations. Cornices will also be unstable and prone to collapse. Below 900 metres, wet snow instabilities will be present in many steep locations. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable

Strong South-West winds with precipitation, falling as snow above 1000 metres.
